Some of the programs they provide are college prep, GED completion, case management and social justice. In 2019-2020 they assisted 155 youth with case management and academic assistance. They are at Tyee High School and have assisted 10 youth at risk in SeaTac this year. Marcus shared a little about his background and history of being “on the streets” and told some uplifting outcomes he had with the youth he’s currently working with. They continue to do outreach and help youth from ages 12-24 and will meet them wherever they feel most comfortable. They are currently looking for a program manager.
