Page 13/46, Proposed TIP Resolution: Signature for Mayor should say "Jake Simpson" rather than Erin Sitterley

Page 43/46: Drawing shows water line relocated to the south side of S. 204th St. and then on the west side of 34th Ave. S. immediately south of S. 204th St. Traditionally in our region water is on the north and east sides of right-of-ways, and natural gas is on the south and west sides. What is the reason for this significant variance? Has this non-traditional utility placement been approved by the other potentially affected utilities?
