

Interlocal Agreement with Highline School District – July 7, 2022

Presentation Overview

PURPOSE OF PRESENTATION

Seeking a recommendation from the Parks and Recreation Committee to bring forward the City Council an Interlocal Agreement between the City of SeaTac and the Highline School District No. 401 for sharing the facility use at Valley Ridge Park and the Tye Educational Complex parking lot.

IMPORTANCE OF THIS TOPIC

1. Original contract between SeaTac and Highline School District expired in 2020. This agreement is ONLY with Tye Educational Complex.
2. No significant changes were made by either party.
3. ILA allows both parties to utilize facilities for programs during afterschool, weekdays, and weekends.
4. There is no cost associated with this ILA.
5. The duration of the ILA will be ten years.



CITY'S USE OF THE TYEE EDUCATIONAL COMPLEX

- Can use on weekends, after-school and summer months at no cost.
- Not allowed to use parking lot during school hours or school programming.
- No cost associated with usage of the parking lot.
- Mainly used for special events (examples: Touch-A-Truck, Recycle Events) and for overflow parking.



HIGHLINE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S USE OF VALLEY RIDGE FACILITIES

- Can use during school hours, after school, and on weekends (if available).
- Sport teams and physical education classes must provide a schedule and complete a facility use permit with the City for approval of weekend use.
- Can use park facilities during normal school days until 5:00 pm.
- Can use park facilities when school is not in session on weekends and weekdays (if available) at no cost.



COMMITTEE REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION
