4	Streetscape Discussion	<p>Will Appleton, Director of Public Works, Jenn Kester, Planning Manager, and Florendo Cabudol City Engineer, presented this streetscape update. Streetscape provides for aesthetic design, pedestrian and bike friendly options, seating, public art, planters, bike parking, and other elements. 5	Department Update	<p>Florendo Cabudol, City Engineer, gave a department update regarding sidewalks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 34th Avenue South Project South 160th Street - South 166th Street is the entering final stages of project. Property restoration will begin late March and April 1 for final asphalt pavement rift. Streetlighting and hardscapes are in. We are on schedule and under budget to have this project completed in Spring 2023 • River Ridge Elementary is currently in design. Kent School District is the lead in this project contracting to build the project in SeaTac. The goal of this project is to create and construct a continuous sidewalk connection.
