All of this is to help break the cycle of abuse and to thrive. Only 1% of people experiencing DV will go to an organization like Lighthouse. Most will go to community organizations like churches, or they will talk to their friends. Average stay time is about 2 years. The initial ask is for them to only stay for 3 months. Quote "for the first time in 13 years I feel safe, comfortable and fed "– resident of Sasha's House.

5. Human Services Updates	 Kim Cooper presented updates: Met with WorkSource to get a job fair going in the city. Finishing up on 39 contracts, Westside Baby requested they not be funded. Bow Lake Mobile Home Park is working with Fuller Electric to replace electrical panels in the outdated mobile homes. Working on the new Resource Guide. We will list all the agencies we are currently funding as well as other agencies available in SeaTac. We usually pass out about 700-1000 fliers. We are still advertising for an opening on this Advisory Committee. Kim will start scheduling 3 agencies per month to present at the meeting.
