PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Demolish the existing 129,000 SF Tyee High School on site and replace it with a new 210,000 SF educational facility serving grades 9-12 with a capacity for 1,200 students. The new facility will be one cohesive building comprised of one, two, and three stories with associated surface parking, drop-off/pick-up, and bus circulation. The project also includes renovation of the existing track and field.
