SEATAC CAFÉ UPDATE: Senior van lunch pickups have increased. Five to seven people are being picked up daily. Wednesdays and Thursdays are becoming quite busy. On Thursdays there are typically 35 to 40 SeaMar clients. The Father's Day Lunch was very successful with 118 attendees. Ice Cream Treats for the luncheon were provided to us from Heights by Vintage SeaTac. Serving help from recreation and city hall staff was greatly appreciated.

Catholic Community Services will no longer allow menu changes outside of holiday meals. All sites must serve the same meals on the same days.

There will be a new Meet and Greet activity for seniors new to the Senior Program. It will be held every first Friday at 10:00 AM to answer questions, introduce ourselves, and have a little fun with our new participants. This is a drop-in activity, and everyone is welcome to attend.

Emergency Response "Code Red" for Seniors: individuals can call and make an appointment with Amy or Linda to assist them with getting connected with Code Red. This service is for keeping the public updated with the most current information in the event of a disaster.

OLD BUSINESS: The committee viewed the Open Public Meetings Act training video.

The new adult services librarian at Valley View Library, Beatriz Esparragoza, will be leading a writing class on the second Friday of each month at 10:00 AM, starting July 14. She will also offer tech help appointments on the same afternoon.
