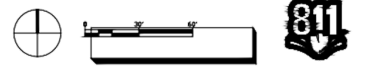

- Council Approved Funding \$40,000
- Coordination and Advertising of Call to Artist
- Provide space for community voice meetings
- Work with architect and artist for installation of the art pieces
- Maintenance and Preservation
