Subject: Planning Commission Kick-Off: Envision SeaTac 2044 Phase 2 Community Conversation -

Where and How Will SeaTac Grow in the Next 20 Years

The upcoming briefing will kick-off the Planning Commission's work on Phase 2 of the Envision SeaTac 2044 Project. Phase 2 will focus on facilitating community input on where and how the city will accommodate new housing and job growth over the next 20 years, while concurrently identifying potential updates to related policies in the Comprehensive Plan. The main goals of Tuesday's briefing are to:

- Provide an overview of the Planning Commission's role and anticipated activities as the main community advisory group through each phase of the Envision SeaTac 2044 project,
- Present an update on the Phase 1 community engagement process and a final invitation to participate in the Phase 1 Community Conversation/ "City Vision Poll," which will close at the end of November, and
- Kick-off the Planning Commission's Phase 2 project work by facilitating a "deep dive discussion" on the Comprehensive Plan's Land Use Element and Background Report, and key policy guidance on where and how the city should grow.

ENVISION SEATAC 2044 PROJECT BACKGROUND

The main goal of the Envision SeaTac 2044 project is to undertake a major update of the Comprehensive Plan, as required by the state Growth Management Act, and re-set the City's growth and development strategies for the years 2024-2044. Updates will incorporate community priorities and align with new state and regional growth requirements and the project will include a robust, inclusive, and continuous community engagement process. The Envision project will closely coordinate with and leverage work from the Transportation Master Plan (TMP) update and City Center/Airport District Subarea Plan projects, which are also underway. (These three projects are collectively known as the "Planning Our City Together" projects.)
