5. Reorganization/ Reclassifications A. Finance and Systems B. Parks and Rec. C. Legal	City Manager Carl Cole presented a series of proposals to the committee. These proposals encompassed reorganizing the Finance and System Department, making Systems a separate department. The reclassifications and compensation adjustments for key positions include the Information Systems Director, GIS Manager, and Information Systems Administrator. In addition, a proposal was made for the Parks and Recreation Department to elevate the Parks Projects and Operations Manager position to a Deputy Director level. Lastly, a proposal for the Legal Department to reclassify the role of Assistant City Attorney to the Senior Assistant City Attorney.

Mid-Biennium Budget Amendment	Recommendation for Council Approval as an Action Item  Gwen Pilo, Director of Finance & Systems, Mei Barker, Human Resources Director; and Carl Cole, City Manager, presented a midbiennium budget amendment. The presentation includes updates to 2024 revenues, expenditures, 2023 performance indicators, department objectives, and decision card considerations.  The committee recommended this item for approval, and it will be presented for action after the required Public Hearing at the November 28, 2023, Regular Council Meeting.
7a. 2024 Property Tax Levy	Recommendation for Council Approval as an Action Item  Gwen Pilo, Director of Finance & Systems, Gwen Pilo presented an overview of the 2024 property tax levy. The council sets the required funding amount while adhering to a financial policy not to increase the levy when General Fund reserves are met. The presentation also highlighted banked capacity and limitations on levy amounts, with adjustments based on assessed valuation and statutory rates impacting property taxes for residents.
