Airport Protestors Arraigned in SeaTac Court

DATE: Monday, May 14, 2024

SEATAC, WA – On Monday, May 13, 38 of the 46 demonstrators arrested by Port of Seattle police officers during a protest that blocked traffic outside SEA International Airport on April 15 were arraigned on misdemeanor charges of failure to disperse and disorderly conduct.

Eight of the 46 defendants have hired private counsel and waived arraignment. Each charge against each defendant carries a maximum penalty of 90 days in jail and a maximum of \$1,000 in fines.
