#### **Specifications**

Exhibit is for black/white and color original photography. All work must be matted, framed and ready to hang with wire. Maximum size not to exceed 3 feet vertically or horizontally including mat and frame. Minimum photo size 5" x 7". Photos submitted should be appropriate for public display and suitable for community viewing. Photos submitted may be printed by the photographer or a photo lab. All works must have a 3 x 5 card attached to the lower right back and must include:

- Photographers name, address, day and evening phone numbers.
- Title of piece, year of execution and price (not to exceed \$750).
