WHEREAS, on or around Nov. 1st, 2024 the Washington State Administrative Office of the Court (AOC) took all judicial information systems offline on to contain and investigate a recent cyberattack;

WHEREAS AOC's response included isolating their system to contain the threat and rebuild its system;

WHEREAS the Court's inability to access the AOC system during this time affects nearly all aspects of Court operations such as judicial review of defendant's Washington State criminal, warrant, and order history as well as court clerk processes such as filing new cases, docketing events and hearings, receipting payments, and scheduling future court dates.

WHEREAS, the loss of the judicial information systems at AOC affects all aspects of court operations and has created an emergency requiring this Court to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders, and to take further action concerning court operations as warranted to address the current state of emergency;

WHEREAS public safety, as well as the rights of parties, defendants, and victims may be adversely impacted by the Court's inability to maintain usual operations and in the absence of further guidance or action from the Washington State Supreme Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. All court rules, policies, procedures, and statutes regarding filing, scheduling, docketing, and transmitting information are suspended until the AOC judicial information systems are restored.
- 2. All court rules, policies, procedures, and statutes regarding the posting of payments are suspended until the AOC judicial information systems are restored.
- 3. All time requirements of CrRLJ 3.3, CrRLJ 4.1, CrRLJ 4.7, IRLJ 2.1, IRLJ 2.6 (both civil infractions and vehicle related violations) and any other court rule, policy,

procedure, or statute governing 'time' will be suspended until further Order of the Court.

4. This Order shall remain in effect until November 27, 2024, unless later rescinded, modified, or extended by the Court.
