Fourth of July Parking

The City offers our regrets to any citizens who were inconvenienced by a lack of overflow parking at Alaska Airlines on the Fourth of July. Although the City of SeaTac has used the Alaska Airlines parking lot with permission from the company during the last several years for overflow parking during the Fourth of July fireworks show at Angle Lake, there was never written approval to do so. Unfortunately, on-site security was unaware of this informal arrangement and did not allow parking this year. Alaska Airlines is a fantastic community partner as they provide overflow parking for many special events, such as our Easter Egg Hunt, Music in the Park, International Festival, and Theatre in the Park. We are currently working with Alaska Airlines to formally provide the necessary overflow parking for the 2012 Fourth of July fireworks show.

Civil Service Commission

The City of SeaTac has an immediate vacancy for a Civil Service Commissioner. SeaTac Firefighters Certify in Water Rescue



This June, twelve SeaTac firefighters attended a three-day Swift Water Rescue course. The course provides rescuers with the fundamentals of survival in moving water and is recommended for anyone who may be called upon to effect in-water rescues. Students gain knowledge in hydrology and river classifications, size-up, site control, and scene management.

Practical skills include self-rescue, swift water swimming and the fundamentals of shore, boat, and in-water rescues. Additionally, students are introduced to the basics of boat handling and the fundamentals of rope rescue involving mechanical advantage and anchor systems.



River safety

Rivers are inherently dangerous places to recreate. The water is swift and cold, and logs and rocks pose navigation hazards. Rivers are dynamic systems that change constantly from year to year.

This year, river flows are especially high, fast and cold because of an unusually heavy amount of mountain snow melting into King County rivers. Because of this, King County requires the use of a Coast Guard approved lifejacket or personal flotation device (PFD) on all major rivers in unincorporated King County.

Remember, life jackets float. You don't.

This program will fill a void for many children that are recipients of free/reduced lunch during the school year.


