New Futures Program Director, Dana Bowles, shared they focus on ensuring children's success in school and life by providing an Early Learning Program that teaches preschool children skills that readies them for kindergarten, while helping parents build skill to support their children's life-long learning and development; the After School Program that helps young minds grow throughout the school year and into summer by providing academic support and enrichment activities; and the Youth Program which supports students through ongoing home work assistance, academic tutoring and mentoring, and enrichment activities that allows students to explore educational and career opportunities. In addition they offer a skills training program with their Parent Involvement work focused on Strengthening Families. So far this year, 415 unduplicated served with 5,000 hours after school, 4,900 youth service hours and 175 family visits. All outcomes have been met.
