Public Works Inspectors Earn Certification

On November 17, Senior Public Works Inspectors Mark Hasbargen and Scott Douglas earned their Certified Public Infrastructure Inspector Certifications (CPII) after passing the American Public Works Association (APWA) exam. Eligibility requirements for the exam included a minimum of five years of field construction inspection experience, and knowledge of construction of various types of infrastructure from bridges to roadways. The purpose of the CPII is to promote quality infrastructure throughout the community by advancing the knowledge and practice of construction inspection to benefit the community and public agencies. SeaTac Public Works Inspectors not only ensure compliance with infrastructure plans and specifications, they also provide extensive customer service to our residents and businesses to ease disruptions during construction. David Carnes, Public Works Inspector Supervisor, led the effort for CPPI certification in SeaTac when he earned his CPII in 2010. Congratulations to David, Mark and Scott on a job well done!

SeaTac Fire Assists Kent in Vehicle Rescue

On November 23 at approximately 5:50 AM, SeaTac Engine 45 responded with Kent units to a motor vehicle accident in the 2100 block of Orillia Road S. The car had slid off of the road and down an embankment. Engine 45 found the car over the embankment resting on its nose with rear of car in the air up against a tree. The roof of the vehicle was against the tree. The driver's door was wedged against another tree and would not provide access to the driver. The passenger side door would have been too much of a drop off to access the driver and would have put the crew on the downhill side of the vehicle. Engine 45 utilized Kent's Ladder 74 to attach Engine 45's winch cable to the vehicle and secure car from tipping over. Engine 45 cut the windshield out of the vehicle and extricated the driver with the attic ladder. The driver was not injured and required no medical attention.

Meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month at SeaTac City Hall.
