

City Manager's Weekly Update

January 20, 2012

Dear Mayor, Councilmembers, Residents, and Employees:

Inclement Weather in SeaTac: Over the last week, the City of SeaTac, along with the rest of the Puget Sound region, has been working to overcome the freezing temperatures, snow and ice that Mother Nature has presented. Preparations started last weekend as we followed the weather forecasts leading up to this week's weather event. City maintenance crews were placed on 12-hour shifts for round-the-clock coverage beginning Sunday afternoon. Throughout the week, crews applied anti-icing solution, plowed and sanded priority locations throughout the city's road network. Our Police and Fire Departments handled numerous calls related to the inclement weather, many of which were related to traffic accidents, blocking vehicles and trees down.

If you become aware of a condition needing a Public Works response, you may call 206.973.4770 on weekdays between 7am-3:30pm. After hours, please contact the King County after hours dispatch at 206.296.8100. As always, if you have an emergency situation, call 911.

On behalf of our maintenance crews, firefighters, and police officers, the City appreciates the community's patience and your support of their efforts.

Allied Waste Services during Inclement Weather Conditions: Allied Waste was unable to provide collection services in some areas this week due to the inclement weather conditions. If your residential service for garbage, recycling, or yard waste was not collected due to the recent weather conditions, please note the following **inclement weather policy** information provided by Allied Waste.

If weather conditions prevent collection of garbage, recycling, and/or food and yard waste, please remove the containers from the street.

Up to twice the regular amount of garbage will be accepted at no additional charge on the *next* regularly scheduled collection day on your block. No credit is given for delayed residential collection due to weather conditions, but up to twice the regular amount is accepted at no charge to compensate for the missed collection.

Excess materials due to missed collection can be put in a temporary container, such as a box or paper bag marked "Garbage," "Recycling", or "Yard Debris". There is no limit on the amount of accepted recyclables for collection.
