Winter Storm Information

Sandbags for SeaTac residents:

As the temperature rises and the rain falls, the City of SeaTac is providing a limited quantity of pre-filled sandbags for free. SeaTac residents and businesses can pick them up at the SeaTac Maintenance Facility located at 2000 S. 136th St., SeaTac. Sandbags do not seal out water but can help redirect water flow when used properly. Please use with caution and avoid redirecting water to a neighboring property. Please take just what you need as our supplies are limited.

Daytime Warming Shelter for Saturday, December 21, 2012:

If you know of SeaTac residents without power, please let them know the SeaTac Community Center is open Saturday from 10 AM – 4 PM and is available to residents as a warming shelter during operating hours. The address is 13735 -24th Avenue S., SeaTac.

Reporting storm-related issues:

If you are calling to report downed power lines south of South 160th St, call Puget Sound Energy at 1-888-225-5773.

If you are calling to report downed power lines north of South 160th St, call Seattle City Light at (206) 684-7400.

If you are calling to report downed trees in a roadway after-hours, call 206.296.8100. If during normal operating hours, call the SeaTac Maintenance Facility at 206.973.4770.
