City Receives Sustained Support Award

The Parks and Recreation Department received the 4Culture Sustained Support award in the amount of \$7,500 for 2012. The award will assist in the **CULTURE** funding of the annual Music in the Park Concert Series and Theater in the Park programs this summer. King County's 4Culture Sustained Support program invests in a variety of cultural events throughout King County. This funding allows the City to continue to provide diverse and free entertainment for SeaTac residents and surrounding communities.

Orienteering at North SeaTac Park

An orienteering event will be held at an orienteering course in North SeaTac Park on Saturday, March 10 from 5:30-9:30 PM. This event is coordinated by Cascade Orienteering Club of Seattle. Orienteering is a family sport that requires navigational skills using a map and compass to navigate from point to point in diverse and usually unfamiliar terrain and normally moving at a good speed. Participants are given a topographical map which they use to locate the points. Orienteering is a popular sport which is included in the World Games.

Information will include process, schedule, and applications for proposing an individual amendment to the Comprehensive Plan, or to the Development Regulations (Zoning Code). Staff will be available to answer any questions that citizens may have. The deadline to submit your amendment application is Friday, March 30.

Passport Acceptance Times Increased at City Hall

Passport applications are now being accepted Monday through Friday 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon and 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM. Service is being increased January 2012 through March 2012 on a trial basis only. If these increased times are beneficial to the City and residents, it will continue indefinitely.

Maple Tree Replacement at City Hall

One of the substantial Red Maples on the east side of the City Hall parking lot has extensive rot approximately five feet up the trunk. This damage was caused by an improper pruning cut done several years ago, more than likely before the City acquired the property. Due to the nature of this damage, this tree will need to be removed. The work is scheduled for Sunday, March 11 in order to minimize the impact to parking and traffic around City Hall.

Once the damaged tree and stump are removed, we have contracted a company to transplant a similar tree from the back of the City Hall property. That tree will be replaced with a smaller tree of the same species. This is similar to the plan that we used in 2006 when one of the Maples along S. 188th Street went into decline. Transplanting a tree from one part of the property to the other is able to be done at a substantially lower cost than purchasing a replacement tree of approximately the same caliper.

What to bring to the tax site:

- W-2s or other statements for you and your spouse from ALL your employers
- · Picture ID
- Social Security card or ITIN number and birthdates for everyone on your return
- Any 1099 Forms (for income from interest, dividends, retirement, social security or unemployment)
- Name, address and taxpayer identification number of child care provider if you pay for daycare
- Records of student loan payments
- Records of payments for educational expenses, such as college tuition
- Mortgage interest and property tax statements if you own a home
- Bank account number, for direct deposit
- A copy of last year's tax return, if you have it
- If filing jointly, both filer and spouse must be present to file electronically


