Comments:  Jeff Robinson provided a recap of the Riverton Heights process and report from the consultants, Pomegranate Center. The City is moving forward, an RFP has been distributed to various consultant firms for the next phase of site planning Multi-sports Complex – Hotel/Motel funds will support a study for a multi use facility that would be used for tournaments, etc. This will be a feasibility study for an outside firm to build and operate the multi-sport complex. Three proposals were received, reviewed, and phone interviews conducted. A land economics consultant was selected.  Tourism promotion area: Two communities to endorse creation of tourism promotion area under new Washington Tourism Allowance Program which will be supported by a \$2/night "lodging fee" to promote tourism locally.  Lodging tax revenue is up from last year (2010 - \$500,000; 2011 - \$600,000); hotel reservations up.
