# Fourth of July Fireworks Display at Angle Lake Park

We hope everyone has a safe and enjoyable Fourth of July holiday. We want to remind our residents that the possession and discharging of fireworks is **strictly prohibited**. This includes both fireworks purchased at Reservation stands and those purchased off Reservation property.

Help keep our residents, businesses, and environment safe. If you see or hear fireworks being discharged, call 9-1-1. Please remember that high call volumes on and near the Fourth of July may delay non-life and property responses by the police and fire departments.



For those who wish to enjoy fireworks this Fourth of July, the City is co-sponsoring a fireworks display along with the Angle Lake Shore Club again this year. Fireworks will begin at approximately 10:00 PM on July 4. Angle Lake Park will remain open late in order for patrons to enjoy the show. Overflow parking is available at Alaska Airlines located just north of the park.

### Relay for Life

On June 9 & 10, SeaTac city employees on Team SeaTac participated in the Relay for Life of Highline at the Mt. Rainier High School track. The team was formed in support of city residents, city employees, and their family members and friends that have battled cancer. This is an American Cancer Society fundraising event. The overnight Relay for Life walks were developed by Dr. Gordy Klatt from Tacoma in the mid 1980's and have since spread nationwide with over

5000 events planned. He said, "Cancer does not sleep and neither will we." Unfortunately, Dr. Klatt is now battling stomach cancer. In spite of that, he made it to the Tacoma Relay for Life this year. Team SeaTac contributed \$483.35 through donations and fundraising efforts. The Highline event raised \$31,834. Relay for Life is a life-changing event that helps communities across the globe celebrate the lives of people who have battled cancer, remember loved ones lost, and fight back against the disease.



# **Citizen Advisory Committee Vacancies**

The City of SeaTac has immediate vacancies on the Hotel/Motel Tax Advisory Committee and Senior Citizen Advisory Committee. The deadline for applying is July 6, 2012.

The Hotel/Motel Tax Advisory Committee assists the City Council in Hotel/Motel Tax related decisions. The Hotel/Motel Tax Advisory Committee consists of nine members each serving three year terms. Meetings are held at SeaTac City Hall on the second Wednesday of each month for Hotel/Motel and the third Tuesday of each month for the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee at SeaTac City Hall. The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee consists of five members each serving three year terms. Committee members are appointed by the Mayor and City Council. The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee's Mission is to work with the Staff Liaison to identify issues related to senior citizens in the community; act as an advisory body to the City Council and provide input through the City Manager and the Staff Liaison to the City Council on issues relating to SeaTac senior citizens; provide increased opportunities for

community involvement by SeaTac senior citizens and the community in general; advise the City Council, through the City Manager and the Staff Liaison regarding the delivery of senior citizen programs and provide outreach to the community in an effort to develop and place senior citizen issues before the citizens of the City of SeaTac in a positive manner.
