		 Kertzman reported that the vacation Planners have been so popular that a second printing will need to occur to meet expected demand through the end of the year. The winter campaign and contest attracted 500 entries and with so many the SSVS website will continue to post several others throughout the year.
		 The websites banner ads are being refreshed to attract more click-throughs. There were 28,900 unique visits to the website in March.
		 A question was asked about the use of social media sites and Kertzman explained that the SSVS site was obtainable through Facebook and Twitter links on mobile media. March was the first month that clicks leaving

	the website to partner websites had been tracked. There were 13,800 clicks to partner websites; 2,700 to the Travelocity booking pages; 740 to individual hotel pages; and, 751 total packages were referred.

Military ConFam Hosted by SSVS, Meilee Anderson	X Informational UpdateRecommended for:ApprovalApproval with modificationsDenialReferred to: • Anderson reported that 25 reunion planners from across the country would be participating in the Military CONFAM and explained the importance of this activity to attract large events. • SSVs raised over \$26,000 in donations and sponsorships from area business. • The CONFAM will have a trade show with 16 vendors and will make visits to the Museum of Flight, Tillicum Village on an Argosy cruise, the Pike Place Market and the Space Needle. • The Doubletree was the official host hotel for the reunion planners. • Anderson reported that there are approximately 6,000 military reunions annually and that the average stay of 3-5 days in hotels generates between \$35,000 - \$75,000 in lodging and other related expenditures.
