

	approximately \$220,000 under budget.

The recommendations for vehicle replacements were presented. They include the purchase of hybrid vehicles to reduce fuel consumption and carbon emissions. Staff was requested to look for opportunities for more efficiency and report back to Council.

Discussion on creating a Transportation Benefit District	X_Informational UpdateRecommended for:ApprovalApproval with modificationsDenial _X_Referred to A&F 4/14/09 Information regarding the option to implement a Transportation Benefit District (TBD) was presented. The revenue from a TBD could be used for necessary transportation infrastructure preservation and maintenance. If a \$20 vehicle license fee were implemented, the projected annual revenue to the City would be approximately \$400,000. The 20-year bond amount would be approximately \$7 million. The TBD would be formed to fund specific projects and would be dissolved when those projects are complete and any outstanding debt is paid. Staff was requested to present more information at the April 14 A&F Committee Meeting.

Passed: Annual Fire Hose Testing - \$5,036

Passed: Mosquito Larvicide Application - \$16,800

Passed: Move Video Recorders at City Hall to 3rd Floor IT Server Room - \$15,977

Removed: Active Network "Membership" Software Proposal - \$6,156

Agenda Bill #3066; Resolution #09-005 authorizing the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to a Development Agreement (DA) with Washington Mutual (WAMU) was passed and became effective March 24, 2009.

Agenda Bill #3067; Motion authorizing final acceptance of the Westside Trail Improvements Project (South 134th Street to South 156th Street) and establishing a 45-day lien period *was carried and became effective March 24*, 2009.

Agenda Bill #3050; Ordinance #09-1010 amending the 2009 Annual City Budget for 2008 Carryovers was adopted March 24, 2009 and becomes effective April 4, 2009.

Agenda Bill #2968; Ordinance #09-1011 repealing Chapter 3.30 of the SeaTac Municipal Code and adding a new Chapter 3.31 to the SeaTac Municipal Code related to Purchasing was adopted March 24, 2009 and becomes effective May 1, 2009.

Agenda Bill #2932; Resolution #09-006 amending the City Council Administrative Procedures, amending the format for agendas for Council meetings *was passed and became effective March 24, 2009.*

Agenda Bill #3057; Motion authorizing the City Manager or their designee to be the "Designated Representative" of the City for purposes of the South Correctional Entity Interlocal Agreement was carried and became effective March 24, 2009.
