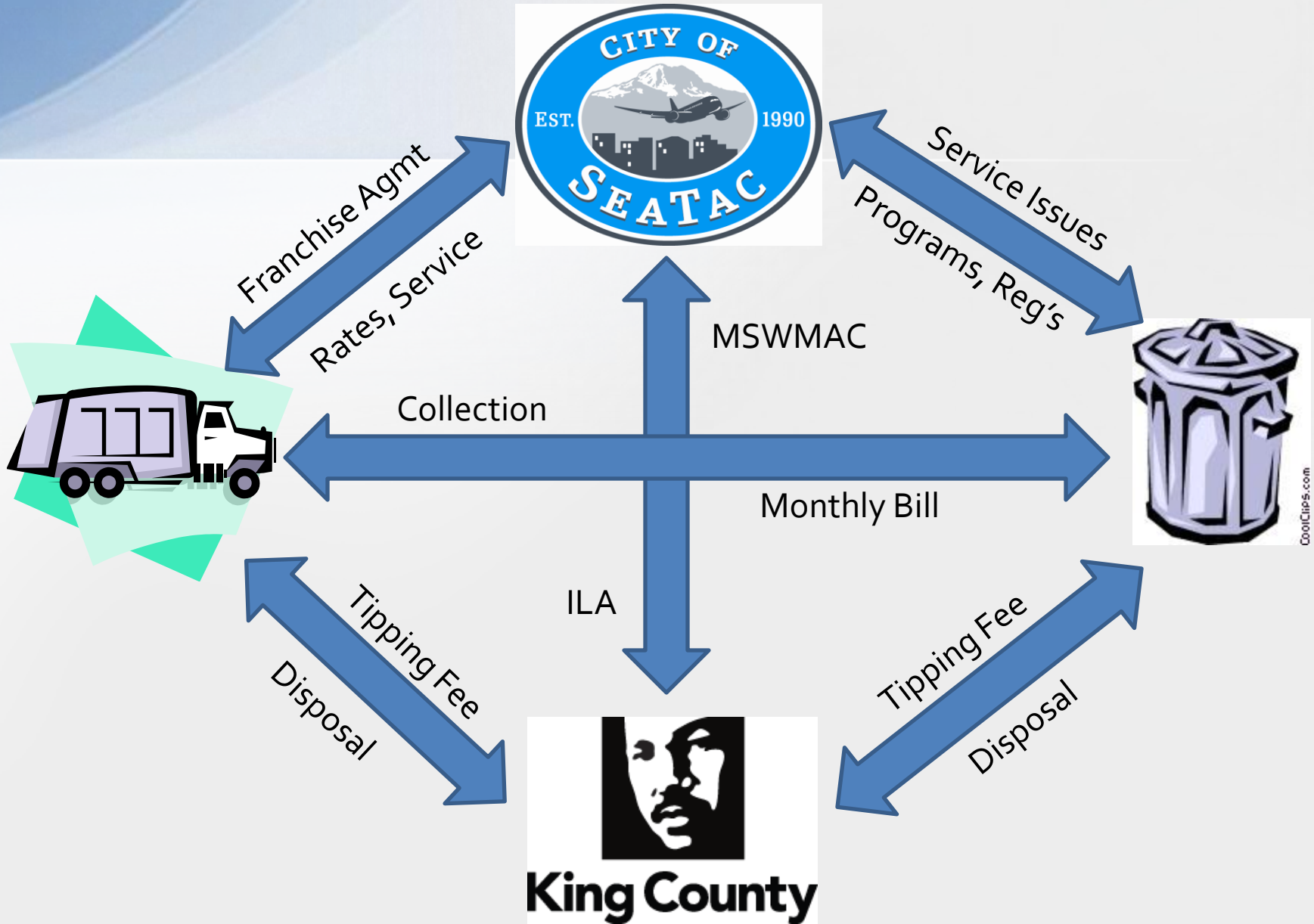
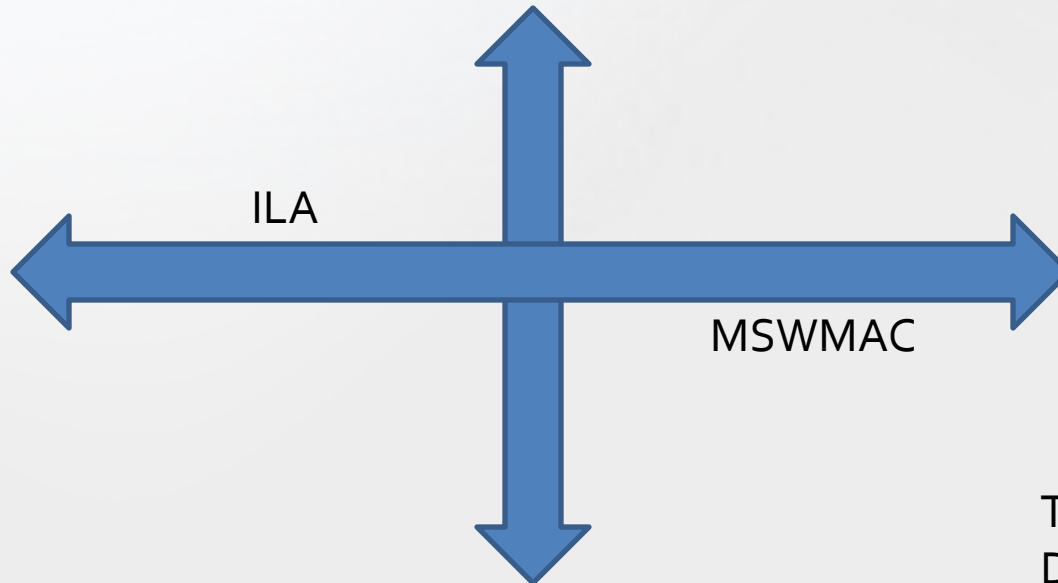

## Current ILA

- Term: 1988-2028
- Regional Policy Committee
- City receives from King County:
  - Statutory Responsibilities
    - Solid Waste Handling (transfer system, disposal)
    - Comprehensive SW Plan
  - Programs: Recycling & Hazardous Mat'ls grants

## Current ILA

- City provides King County:
  - Commitment to utilize system
- Collection: City Responsible

# Amended & Restated ILA

## Key Benefits

- Extends by 12.5 years
  - Allows long-term financing, lower rates
- Protects long-term liability
- Expands City role in System planning
- Adds new mitigation section
- Adds new dispute resolution section
- Updated to be consistent with current conditions and laws
