




## **Applicability of Proposed Code**

#### **Proposed Code Applies to:**

- Park-and-Fly Parking Structures
- Developments proposing to <u>include</u> Park-and-Fly operations
- Projects in City Center only



# **Key Changes in Proposed Code**

Code changes can be divided into 2 categories:

- 1. Number of Park-and-Fly Stalls
- 2. Building Design and Function



# Building Design & Function

## **Proposed Standards:**

- Building Setbacks
- Ground Floor Commercial Space
- Building Façade Treatments
- Open Space
- City Center Road Standards





### **Public Hearing Highlights**

- In Support: 4 Speakers
  - AHC worked collaboratively for a long time, it was a community effort, everyone compromised
  - AHC recommendation should be supported
  - Preliminary Planning Commission recommendation should be supported
- Against: 3 Speakers
  - No need for change
  - Same standards as used by previous developers should be kept to ensure quality projects
  - Inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan

#### **Proposed Code and Comprehensive Plan**

- City reviews all code amendments to ensure implementation of Comprehensive Plan
- The review done through the SEPA evaluation
- SEPA review found proposed code to be <u>consistent</u> with the Comprehensive Plan except for the AHC proposal to remove City Center specific road standards
  - This resulted in a MDNS (Mitigated Determination of Non Significance) issuance
- No SEPA appeals were filed that challenged this finding
- 11/13/2012: Council directed that City Center road standards be maintained for park-and-fly projects


