The wide ranging measures were presented and shared with the committee. Kertzman also shared information on the results of website impressions which have diminished recently due to a lack of budget which was redeployed for general operations and printing needs. Conversions were up in September from 66 in 2011 to 85 in 2012. 73 of these were for SeaTac hotels. This was an increase from the 55 in September 2011.
