Agency Presentation(s) There was not an agency presentation this evening.

New Business King County update: In November 2012, the Metropolitan King County Council passed Motion 13768 which called for the King County Executive, in collaboration with a community stakeholder panel informed by local and national expertise, to develop a plan for an accountable and integrated system of health, human services, and community-based prevention and wellness. The plan is due to the Council by June 1, 2013.

As a member of this Transformation Panel, Colleen shared we have an opportunity to work together toward system change that achieves the effective, efficient, timely, and culturally competent delivery of health and human services that will offer better customer service, value wellness and recovery, and achieve financial sustainability for residents of King County.

Colleen shared information on the following:

- Community Building interviews are starting but they are still recruiting
- Back to School Fair planning has begun. New faith based partners are coming forward and previous partners, including Allied Waste, want to do more.
