



### Why a Major Update of the Comprehensive Plan?


- GMA requires periodic update every 7 years
  - Annual amendments <u>not</u> required-City's choice
- Incorporate new growth "targets" through 2031
- Incorporate Comprehensive Transportation Plan update
  - Public works





# **New Policies Required**

- Reduce greenhouse gas emission
- Promote walking and physical activity
- Address the effects of climate change
