Amina Ahmed, Family Support Program Manager from Refugee Women's Alliance shared that Refugees and Immigrants face numerous barriers that prevent them from accessing mainstream public services: limited English proficiency, lack of education and job-related skills, and unfamiliarity with U.S. cultural practices and systems. They need culturally and linguistically appropriate services to meet basic survival needs and establish stability. Their Family Support program staff assists clients to help overcome obstacles by providing services and resources in 20 different languages. Largest populations include: Bhutanese, Nepalese and Burmese. The next newcomers will arrive from the Republic of Congo. They serve a Senior meal on Fridays and Saturdays for 60+. They have 21 volunteers in the Family Support program. 28 staff at the SeaTac office
