




South 200th Link Extension

Construction Alert

"Little 28th Ave. South" temporary long-term road closure

As early as Tuesday, May 7, Sound Transit's contractor, PCL Civil Constructors will close a small stretch of 28th Avenue South (known as "little 28th Ave South") between the main portion of 28th Avenue South and South 200th Street in Sea Tac for construction.

Detour signs will direct you one block west to 28th Ave South.

The initial construction activity will consist of utility relocation on "little 28th Ave South" and the road will remain closed to vehicles and pedestrians for the duration of the construction.

The road will be closed until approximately mid-2016 to build 1.6 miles of light rail on an elevated structure and the new Angle Lake Station. Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service to Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
