

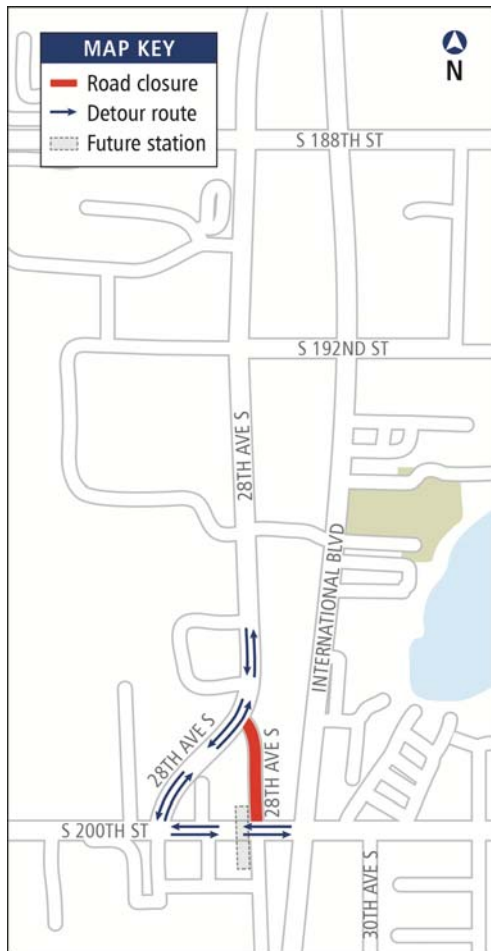


# South 200th Link Extension

## Construction Alert

May 2013

### “Little 28<sup>th</sup> Ave. South” temporary long-term road closure



As early as Tuesday, May 7, Sound Transit’s contractor, PCL Civil Constructors will close a small stretch of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue South (known as “little 28<sup>th</sup> Ave South”) between the main portion of 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue South and South 200<sup>th</sup> Street in Sea Tac for construction.

Detour signs will direct you one block west to 28<sup>th</sup> Ave South.

The initial construction activity will consist of utility relocation on “little 28<sup>th</sup> Ave South” and the road will remain closed to vehicles and pedestrians for the duration of the construction.

The road will be closed until approximately mid-2016 to build 1.6 miles of light rail on an elevated structure and the new Angle Lake Station. Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service to Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
