CSC has served more than 700 students in grades K-12 from the City of SeaTac this school-year to date, of which 93% are racial or ethnic minorities, 40% are refugee or immigrant, and more than 70% are low-income.

Leveraged Funding

Additional Funding Directed to CSC-SeaTac



- \$ 46,370 in health programs and services
 - 78,340 in coordination, professional development and planning
- \$264,467 additional investment in SeaTac Students & Families raised from foundation and individual support.





Highlights

- Parents have been more engaged in their child's school and education through an increase in attendance at events
 - College Night at the Tyee Campus → over 75 families attended, dinner and babysitting provided, and translation and interpretation provided in Spanish and Somali
 - Parent Leadership Events at Chinook → more Latino and Somali families are attending consistently
 - Quarterly Celebration Events at CSC schools
- Over 500 students received preventative dental services
 - Through a partnership with Smile Partners



- Improved student attitudes toward school




Highlights
