Nighttime work at Sea-Tac Airport

Concrete pour for column of new elevated trackway

Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. on Monday, September 9, and 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 10, Sound Transit's contractor, PCL Civil Constructors, will pour a large amount of concrete for a column foundation. This work will take place entirely on Sea-Tac Airport property, near the south entrance at South 182nd Street.

The City of SeaTac has granted a noise variance for this nighttime activity, as there will be increased noise and numerous trucks to the site.

Work is continuing on the S. 200th Link Extension, as crews drill out foundations and place columns for the elevated trackway that will connect Sea-Tac/Airport Station to the future Angle Station at South 200th Street.
