Neighborhood Grant Program Background

- Initial budget \$30,000 for 2006-2008
- Reduced to \$10,000 for 2009
- Suspended in 2010
- Provided up to \$5,000 City match
- Minimum 50/50 match neighborhood to City

Neighborhood Grant Program Pilot Re-Ignition

- Annual Program = \$5,000 max
- City Match per Project = \$5,000 max
- Neighborhood : City Match = 4:1 min
- Eligible Projects
 - Neighborhood Identity Signs
 - Community Gardens, Play Areas
 - Neighborhood Events (Blockwatch, Map Your Neighborhood)
 - Street Lights

Neighborhood Grant Program Pilot Re-Ignition

- Selection

- Criteria:

- Readiness
 - Participation
 - Consistency with Council Vision and Goals

- Example:

New street lights on non-arterial street. Total project cost is \$25k. Neighbors complete project. City reimburses \$5k. Neighbors responsible for ongoing power and maintenance costs.
