

Overnight closure of S. 182nd Street Entrance at Sea-Tac Int'l Airport



An overnight closure of S. 182nd Street entrance at Sea-Tac Int'l Airport will occur from 11:00 PM Wednesday, December 11 until 5:00 AM Thursday, December 12 and again 11:30 PM Thursday, December 12 until 5:30 AM Friday, December 13.

Sound Transit's contractor, PCL Civil Constructors, will temporarily close the S. 182nd Street access to Sea-Tac Airport on International Boulevard and redirect traffic to the entrance at S. 170th Street.

This closure is needed so that a large crane can be moved across the roadway as work continues to build the Link light rail extension to the future Angle Lake Station at S. 200th Street.

Committee Vacancies

The City has immediate vacancies on the Human Services Advisory Committee, Library Advisory Committee and the Tree Board. These committees serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council with five members each, serving three year terms.

The Human Services Advisory Committee is looking for candidates to fill one expiring term. This committee makes reports and recommendations to the City Council concerning human services issues. Meetings are held on the third Monday of each month at SeaTac City Hall beginning at 5:30 PM.

The Library Advisory Committee is looking for candidates to fill one expired term. This committee coordinates with, and provides input to, the Board of Trustees of the King County Library District and local library official. Meetings are held quarterly on the second Wednesday of the month, or as needed, at Valley View Library or SeaTac City Hall at 5:00 PM.

The Tree Board is looking for candidates to fill one expired term. The Tree Board makes reports and recommendations to the City Council concerning a comprehensive Public Tree Care Plan for the Parks and Public Works departments, Public Tree Hazard Assessment and Inventory, and implementing an Arbor Day Observation/Celebration and Proclamation. Meetings are held on an as-needed basis at SeaTac City Hall.
