**BUSINESS**

**Agency Presentation(s)** Beth Church from HealthPoint shared about the comprehensive medical and dental services offered at their clinics. Trends they are addressing include diabetes, high blood pressure, low birth weight babies, and a need for referrals to resources. They have client service reps as well as 24 folks hired to enroll folks in healthcare expansion. Languages include: Somali/Punjabi/Spanish. 83,000 are eligible for healthcare and could receive Medicaid or subsidized care. Medicaid = 133% of Federal Poverty Level or about \$33,000/year. Subsidized care = 400% of FPL. Healthpoint is an accredited, certified, medical home with specialty doctors who focus on community health and prevention. They have surpassed their performance measures for the year.

Lois Linth with Dynamic Family Partners shared their mission is to help children and families with special needs reach their full potential. They have opened a beautiful new facility in Burien but still have a wait list. They try to be in touch with families as soon as the diagnosis occurs. They see huge gains for children the earlier they see them and a significant savings to districts when they are involved.
