Kent Youth and Family Services Executive Director, Mike Heinisch, shared that they served 19 residents, mostly youth and dual diagnosed with mental health and chemical dependency issues. He concluded with a story, from the Seattle Times, about a young woman attending Chinook M.S. who had emotional behavior issues and was self medicating to avoid the trauma she had experienced. They paired her with a co-occurring counselor and tailored treatment to her needs helping her address family issues and cultural barriers. She remains Clean and sober, graduated the treatment program on time and is pursuing her education. KYFS hopes to continue to build relationships with Highline Public Schools and their efforts at Tyee Educational Complex and Chinook M.S.
