




## South 200th Link Extension

## **Construction Alert**

## Temporary lane closure of 26<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> Ave South in SeaTac

Between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. each day, Monday, April 21, through Wednesday, April 23, the northbound lanes of 26<sup>th</sup> Ave/28<sup>th</sup> Ave S. between South 200<sup>th</sup> Street and "little 28<sup>th</sup> Ave S" will be closed.

During this lane closure, all northbound traffic on 26<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> Ave S. will be detoured to the southbound lanes of the roadway.

Sound Transit's contractor, PCL Civil Constructors, will be installing a storm drain within the roadway.

Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service from Angle Lake Station to Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
