Branch Executive Claudia Tanis from the Matt Griffin YMCA shared they served 10,732 meals last year in a partnership with Highline Public Schools, Des Moines Area Food Bank, Wal-Mart Foundation, Cedarbrook Lodge, and the City. Recreation, food for parents and youth including fresh fruit/vegetables were provided. They held 4 community dinners and provided food and recreation during out of school time and holidays.

Somali Youth and Family Club stopped in to meet the committee and share a bit about their agency. They were founded in 2008 to provide essential services to Somali and other underserved families and youth in King County. They are grant funded by SeaTac to provide an early learning Play and Learn group to assist with kindergarten readiness. They assist parents with all age children to address relationship challenges as well as other services to foster self-sufficiency.
