

- New household and employment forecasts (2035)
  - Drive Land Use and Transportation
     Elements
- New policies required (GMA):
  - Reduce greenhouse gas emissions
  - Promote walking and physical activity
  - Address the effects of climate change
- Changes to Housing Element requirements (Countywide Planning Policies)
- GMA requirement

#### 2014: Draft Amendments & Review


- Draft amendments to all Plan Elements
