## Large crane moving across South 188<sup>th</sup> Street and portions of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave South in SeaTac

1) On Thursday, July 31 between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Sound Transit's contractor will move a large construction crane across all lanes of South 188<sup>th</sup> Street. Uniformed police officers will escort the crane safely through the intersection and perform a 'rolling slowdown' or intermittent lane closures. The crane crossing will take approximately 15 minutes to cross the intersection.

The crane will also travel along the active <u>southbound</u> lanes of traffic of 28<sup>th</sup> Ave South, adjacent to the Hampton Inn & Suites and Wally Park Self-Park. That operation will only take 15 minutes, and a small detour will be in place.

2) On Friday, August 1 during normal daytime hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., the crane will continue down the closed lanes of northbound 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue South.

At South 192nd Street, uniformed police officers will escort the crane safely through the intersection, and only take approximately 15 minutes to cross the intersection. The crane will be escorted by trucks and personnel on the ground to make sure that motorists and pedestrians

can access driveways and crosswalks in a safe manner.
