




South 200th Link Extension

Construction Alert

August 12, 2014



Nighttime construction at South 200th Street in SeaTac

Beginning Monday, August 18, and continuing <u>nightly</u> until **Thursday**, August 21 between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m., all lanes of South 200th Street will be closed at the intersection of "little 28th Avenue South" in SeaTac.

Sound Transit's contractor, PCL Civil Constructors, will be lifting pre-cast girders, or horizontal beams, to begin construction of the Angle Lake Station over South 200th Street in SeaTac.

Recommended detour:

Eastbound on S. 200th St.:

Detour left onto 26th/28th Ave. S.

Right on either S. 192nd St. **or** S. 188th St.

Right on International Blvd.

Left to return to S. 200th St.

Westbound on S. 200th St.:

Detour right onto International Blvd.

Left on either S. 192nd Street **or** S. 188th St.

Left on 28th Ave. S.

Right to return to S. 200th St.

Detour signs will be posted to get motorists and pedestrians safely around the construction work zone.

Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service between Angle Lake Station and Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
