Construction Alert

Nighttime utility work at South 200th Street in SeaTac

Beginning **Sunday, August 24**, and continuing nightly for approximately two weeks, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m., one lane in each direction of South 200th Street will be closed between 28th Ave S. and International Blvd. in SeaTac.

Puget Sound Energy will be relocating electrical utilities underground at the intersection of S. 200th Street and “little 28th Ave S”.

The City of SeaTac has approved a temporary noise variance for this work and access to local businesses will be maintained.



Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service between Angle Lake Station and Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
