Special Events

The Sign Code allows for a business to have signage for two special events (14 days maximum each) per year*. There is no fee for special event signage approval, but a business must have an active business license and register for the special event by completing a registration form and having it approved by the Planning Division. *If the Special Event does not comply with the current Use of the parcel, then a Temporary Use Permit may be required.

Grand Opening

The Sign Code allows for any new business or business under a new name or completely new management to have a grand opening of up to four weeks in length. There is no fee for a grand opening event, but a business must have an active business license and register for the special event signage by completing a registration form and having it approved by the Planning Division.

Posting of Approval On-Site

Approval of the registration form must be posted on site and available for review by the City's Code Enforcement Officer during the length of the special event or grand opening. Posting of special event signage without registration may result in a citation from Code Enforcement.

least four feet from the outer pavement edge of a roadway where there is no curb and gutter.

• Directional signs are not allowed to be placed on utility poles, trees or existing signs.
